



**Instructions to 1<sup>st</sup> Year M. Tech. Candidates who have been allotted seat in National Spot Round (NSR) regarding Institute Admission for the Academic Year 2017-18**

**Reporting details:**

**Reporting Dates:** 24<sup>th</sup> July, 2017 to 31<sup>st</sup> July, 2017.

**Reporting Time:** 09.30 AM to 5.00 PM.

**1. Document required:**

- I. Printout of provisional admission letter/allotted letter after National Sport Round (NSR) issued by CCMT-2017.
- II. Printout of provisional admission letter issued by CCMT-2017.
- III. **Following documents in original for verification along with one set of self-attested photocopies:**
  - (a) Photo ID proof as per Govt. of India norms.
  - (b) GATE Score Card (2015/2016/2017).
  - (c) Class X (High School) Mark Sheet & Certificate as proof of date of birth.
  - (d) Class XII (Intermediate) Mark Sheet and Certificate.
  - (e) All semesters mark sheet of qualifying examination (B.Tech./B.E.).
  - (f) Degree Certificate/ Provisional Degree Certificate of qualifying examination (B.Tech./B.E.)/ if not available undertaking for late submission.
  - (g) Proof of payment of seat acceptance fee Rs. 42,200/ for OC/OB and Rs. 11,700/ for SC/ST/PwD.
  - (h) Certificate of category (SC/ST), if applicable, issued by the competent authority in the prescribed format (Central Govt. format) available at CCMT-2017 website.
  - (i) Certificate of category of OBC (Central list), if applicable, is to be issued by the competent authority in the prescribed format (Central Govt. format), available at CCMT-2017 website, and should clearly mention that the candidate belongs to Non Creamy Layer. **The certificate should have been issued in financial year 2017-18. viz 1st April 2017 to 31st March 2018.**
  - (j) Certificate for Persons with Disabilities (PWD) in the prescribed format, available at CCMT-2017 website, if applicable. The certificate should be issued from a duly constituted Medical Board.
  - (k) Transfer Certificate (**Original to be submitted at the time of admission**)/ if not available undertaking for late submission.
  - (l) Migration certificate (**Original to be submitted at the time of admission**)/ if not available undertaking for late submission.
  - (m) Latest Character Certificate from the Institute last attended.
  - (n) 10 Passport size photographs.

**\*\* As per the guidelines of Govt. of India, MHRD, tuition fees (Rs. 35,000/-) may not be charged from the SC/ST candidates at the time of admission. However, they have to deposit their tuition fee before the end of the semester through scholarships /bank loan / any other means.**

- Note: (i) The above fee is in addition to the fees paid to the CCMT-2017.**  
**(ii) The above fee covers the Institute fee for the first semester only i.e. Autumn Semester 2017.**  
**(iii) Students should see the Fees Structure from the Institute website.**  
**(iv) Presently Institute is not providing Hostel facility to the M.Tech. students.**

The Institute fees should be paid during admission only through **Demand Draft** in favour of **“The Director, NIT Uttarakhand”** payable at Srinagar (Garhwal).

**Note: Cash/Cheque will not be accepted under any circumstances.**

It is mandatory for all students to open a bank account in SBI, Srinagar Garhwal. There is a provision of opening Bank account in SBI, Srinagar (Garhwal), during admission procedure. All the transactions regarding refunds, scholarship etc. will be performed by the Institute in students above mentioned SBI Account only.

## 3. Refund Rules:

**Note: A student who does not report to the NIT Uttarakhand for Institute reporting/admission shall not be refunded any amount, deposited to CCMT-2017, by the Institute. All refund will be performed by CCMT-2017 in this regard.**

#### **4. How to reach NITUK Campus:**

Temporary Campus is located in Govt. Polytechnic, Srinagar Garhwal (Distt. Pauri Garhwal). Srinagar Garhwal is 105 km from Rishikesh on National Highway No. 58 leading to Badrinath (193 km from Srinagar). Rishikesh is the nearest Railway Station. Haridwar, a major Railway station in Uttarakhand is 130 km from Srinagar Garhwal. Nearest Airport at Jolly Grant, Dehradun is 125 km away from Srinagar Garhwal. Taxis are available for Srinagar Garhwal from Airport. Buses and Taxis are available for Srinagar from Dehradun/Rishikesh/Haridwar. It takes 4 to 5 hours to reach Srinagar from Rishikesh. In rainy season, road may be blocked due to land sliding. Candidates are requested to keep a spare day while planning for reporting. Alternate way to reach Srinagar is from Kotdwara (via Pauri), which is approximately 140 km and takes around 5 to 6 hours.

#### **5. Instructions to the students for reporting:**

- Institute Hostel Facility is not available for the M.Tech Students.
- Each First Year M. Tech. Student and his/her parent/ guardian, have to sign and submit affidavits regarding anti-ragging at the time of reporting to this Institute for admission. An arrangement is made at the Institute for notarizing the affidavits and for this purpose, each student will be required to pay necessary amount in cash towards notary expenses and this amount will be paid by the student to the notary directly at the time of reporting for admission. It is compulsory for each student and his/her parent/guardian to submit the affidavits at the time of reporting for admission and therefore, it is compulsory for each student to report to the Institute with his/her parent/guardian at the time of reporting for admission.
- The Institute will conduct an Induction programme on 01<sup>st</sup> August, 2017 at 09:00 AM in the Auditorium at Govt. Polytechnic Campus of the Institute. It is compulsory for all the students to be present in the auditorium during Induction programme.
- Students are required to appear in a screening test in English and Mathematics. The examinations of English & Mathematics will be conducted from 02.00 pm to 03.00 pm and 03.30 pm to 04.30 pm respectively on 02<sup>nd</sup> August, 2017. The students who are below satisfactory level in these tests are required to register for additional preparatory English and Mathematics courses. Each student is required to get a valid pass grade in these courses in order to be eligible for graduation. The students who will not appear in the examination shall be treated as failed and they have to register for preparatory English and Mathematics courses, which shall be conducted during normal semester from 7.00 pm to 9.00 pm.

- The Classes will commence from 02<sup>nd</sup> August, 2017.
- The Institute will conduct an orientation programme in the afternoon on 03<sup>rd</sup> August, 2017. Attending the programme is compulsory for all the students as Academic structure and Academic system followed in the Institute will be explained to them.
- Students are advised to come prepared with all the items they need. There will not be any possibility of going home till mid-semester break. Students are advised to check the Academic Calendar from the Institute website for details.
- Institute is very strict about attendance in the class and does not accept any excuse for absenteeism. Students are advised to read the ordinances available on Institute website and read carefully the rules regarding absenteeism in the class and examination. Institute does not use any discretion for any reason to relax any of the stipulated conditions.

#### **6. Instructions for Change of Specialization:**

Change of specialization is permitted at the time of reporting as per the following rules:

- Number of candidates in any specialization does not exceed ten with pre-determined reservation for categories.
- Candidates are required to apply for change of specialization, if they wish. However, change in specialization will be allowed on the basis of merit list prepared as per of GATE Score.
- Change of the specialization will be finalized on 01<sup>st</sup> August, 2017 after that specialization shall not be altered any time later.
