ADVERTISEMENT FOR TRAINEE TEACHERS

National Institute of Technology, Uttarakhand is one among 31 NITs created by the Government of India by Act of the Parliament. It offers career opportunity to those who are interested in teaching and research. Applications are invited for the Trainee Teachers Scheme in Electronics/Electrical/Computer Science/Mechanical/Civil Engineering. The scheme is expected to be accomplished by creating bright and talented teaching professionals, providing attractive teaching-cum-research career path to the undergraduate engineers, nurturing undergraduate students and training them effectively so that they become good academicians or researchers. Selected candidates would be engaged as Trainee Teachers at NIT Uttarakhand to assist in teaching and they would simultaneously go through part time M.Tech. and Ph.D. programmes of IITs to acquire higher academic qualifications. After successful completion of the Ph.D. from IIT, the Trainee Teacher (TT) will be absorbed as an Assistant Professor at NIT Uttarakhand in regular scale with all the associated benefits. The services rendered as trainee will be counted for various benefits admissible to employees of NIT Uttarakhand.

Candidates appearing / appeared for Final B.Tech. Examination and whose results are likely to be declared on or before 1st July, 2016 may also apply for the post of Trainee Teachers Scheme. The Govt. of India's Reservation policy including for age relaxation/concession for SC/ST/OBC/PWD and women shall be applicable to NIT Uttarakhand. Interested candidates may apply in prescribed application form, which can be downloaded along with details of posts, qualifications, and general conditions from the Institute website www.nituk.ac.in. The completed applications must reach NIT Uttarakhand on or before 16th March, 2016.

2. The essential qualification for the above scheme is as under:

01.	Trainee Teachers Scheme	Qualification: B.Tech. in relevant discipline from any IIT/NIT/AICTE/UGC approved Institutions/Universities. Essential Qualification: 1 st Division in the relevant discipline either from:- (i) IIT with 8.0 in the scale of 10, or (ii) NIT with 8.5 in the scale of 10, or (iii) Other Institutions/Universities with 8.5 in the scale of 10 or 80% Marks and valid GATE score provided the candidate was eligible for All India Admission to NITs in 2011/2012. (iv) Candidate who are awarded degrees in 2015 or those who shall be eligible for award of Bachelor's Degree in 2016 only are eligible.

4. Selection Procedure:

4.1 All applications shall be scrutinized and incomplete applications will be rejected.

4.2 Candidates not eligible for any post mentioned in the above advertisement shall be disqualified.

4.3 The Institute reserves the right to place a reasonable limit on the total number of candidates to be called for Written Test/Personal Interview. Mere fulfillment of qualification per se does not entitle a candidate to be called for Written Test/Personal Interview.

4.4. Any candidate who graduated in 2015 or is likely to graduate on or before 1st July, 2016 shall be eligible, provided he/she scores atleast as given below:

IIT Graduates	:	8.0 in the scale of 10
NIT Graduates	:	8.5 in the scale of 10
Other Graduates	:	8.5 in the scale of 10 or 80% Marks, provided the candidate was eligible for All India Admission to NITs in 2011/2012.

4.5 For candidates graduating in 2016, only those who have minimum score as mentioned above at the end of 7th semester only shall be eligible for Interview. Score of all 7 semesters shall be considered together.

4.6 First preference shall be given to IIT graduates. Second preference shall be given to NIT graduates and Third preference shall be given to all other graduates, provided the candidate has qualified in AIEEE examination and has a valid GATE score in relevant field.

4.7 In case of NIT and other graduates, merit order shall be created based on AIEEE rank.

4.8 Shortlisted candidates shall be called for Written Test/Personal Interview by email. List of the shortlisted candidates will be available on Institute website i.e. www.nituk.ac.in.

4.9 From amongst the eligible candidates, only limited number of candidates as mentioned in the table below shall be called for a Written Test, as per the criteria of short listing. Short listed candidates will have to appear for written test. From amongst the qualified candidates, only the following number of candidates shall be called for Personal Interview based on merit in the Written Test.

* In addition to above 02 candidates from OBC, 01 from SC, 01 from ST and 01 from PWD category shall be called for Personal Interview on the basis of merit from amongst the candidates who have scored 40% or above marks and could not be included in the list of shortlisted candidates.

§ All candidates belonging to the SC/ST/OBC/PWD shall be called for Written Test irrespective of the shortlisting criteria.

4.10 There shall be no shortlisting criteria for the candidates considered under SC/ST/OBC/PWD category, provided they possess minimum eligibility criteria, to appear for Written Test.

4.11 The written examination shall be conducted for one hour and the examination shall be based on GATE syllabus and will be of multiple choice question type.

4.13 The Written Test and Personal Interview shall be conducted at National Institute of Technology, Uttarakhand. Candidates appearing for Written Test/Personal Interview shall be paid To & Fro Bus/Rail fare by sleeper class upto Haridwar from respective Institute/Hometown, subject to submission of tickets. Transport facility from Haridwar and one day shared accommodation at Srinagar (Garhwal) will be provided. Candidates are free to make their own arrangements. Final schedule of transport facilities that will be provided shall be mentioned in the Interview call letter.

4.14 Candidates are advised to bring Photo ID Card (Driving License, Voters Card, PAN Card, Passport, Aadhaar Card, Bank Pass Book with Photo). However, candidates pursuing B.Tech. shall bring Students ID also. Candidates are further advised to bring all the original documents for verification.

4.15 Selected candidates shall be given direct admission to Ph.D. program at IIT Roorkee based on the above mentioned interview.

4.16 The other benefits like financial support, bonds/commitment for service, employment are clearly mentioned in the salient features of the Trainee Teacher's scheme, which is on page no.5 before the application form.

HOW TO APPLY

- 1.** Candidates willing to apply are requested to download Application Form from the Institute website i.e. www.nituk.ac.in.
- 2.** SC/ST/OBC/PWD candidates also should fill only one application for each post. Such candidates shall also be considered automatically in Open category.
- 3.** Candidates shall complete the form in all respects without leaving any mandatory column blank. Incomplete applications will be rejected. Please enter dash if the information sought is not applicable. No appeal will be considered to correct the information given in application form. Any document submitted separately/subsequently shall not be considered.
- 4.** Candidates should submit self-attested photocopies of certificates and documents mentioned below in the same sequence. No additional documents / certificates should be attached. Applications without copies of appropriate certificates/documents shall be rejected.
 - a.** Proof of Date of Birth (High school certificate/Birth certificate/leaving certificate). In the absence of certificate, application will be summarily rejected.
 - b.** Category Certificate (for SC/ST/OBC candidates only) issued by competent authority, if not attached, application will be considered in OPEN category provided candidate fulfills the age and shortlisting criteria for open category. Non-creamy Layer Certificate (for OBC candidates only) is based on parents' income. Candidates are required to submit OBC certificates along with non-creamy layer certificate valid on 16th March, 2016. However, in the absence of necessary certificates proving category, guidelines issued by Government of India will be followed.
 - c.** For Persons with Disability, Certificate from Competent Authority only will be considered. If no certificate is attached, application will be considered in Open provided such person fulfills the age criteria applicable for open category.
 - d.** Mark Sheets of SSC (X) & HSSC (X+II) must be attached. Final Year Mark sheets/Grade Cards and Degree Certificates for the Examinations mentioned in the Application Form in the same sequence. (Any degree mentioned will not be considered unless certificates are attached). No Degree/Diploma Certificate shall be considered unless supported by Degree/Diploma Certificate or Provisional Degree/Diploma Certificate along with mark sheets. Only a grade card/mark sheet will not be treated as proof of eligibility of the Degree/Diploma, unless it specifically and unconditionally indicates that the student is eligible for award of degree.
 - e.** Rank Certificates (if any).
 - f.** For candidates appearing for final semester Examination, Grade Card/Mark sheets having cleared all 7 semesters should be provided.
 - g.** AIEEE Score Card-2011/2012 (If not attached, NIT candidates shall be placed below those who have submitted AIEEE score card). Without AIEEE score card candidate with degree from Institute other than IIT/NIT shall not be considered eligible.

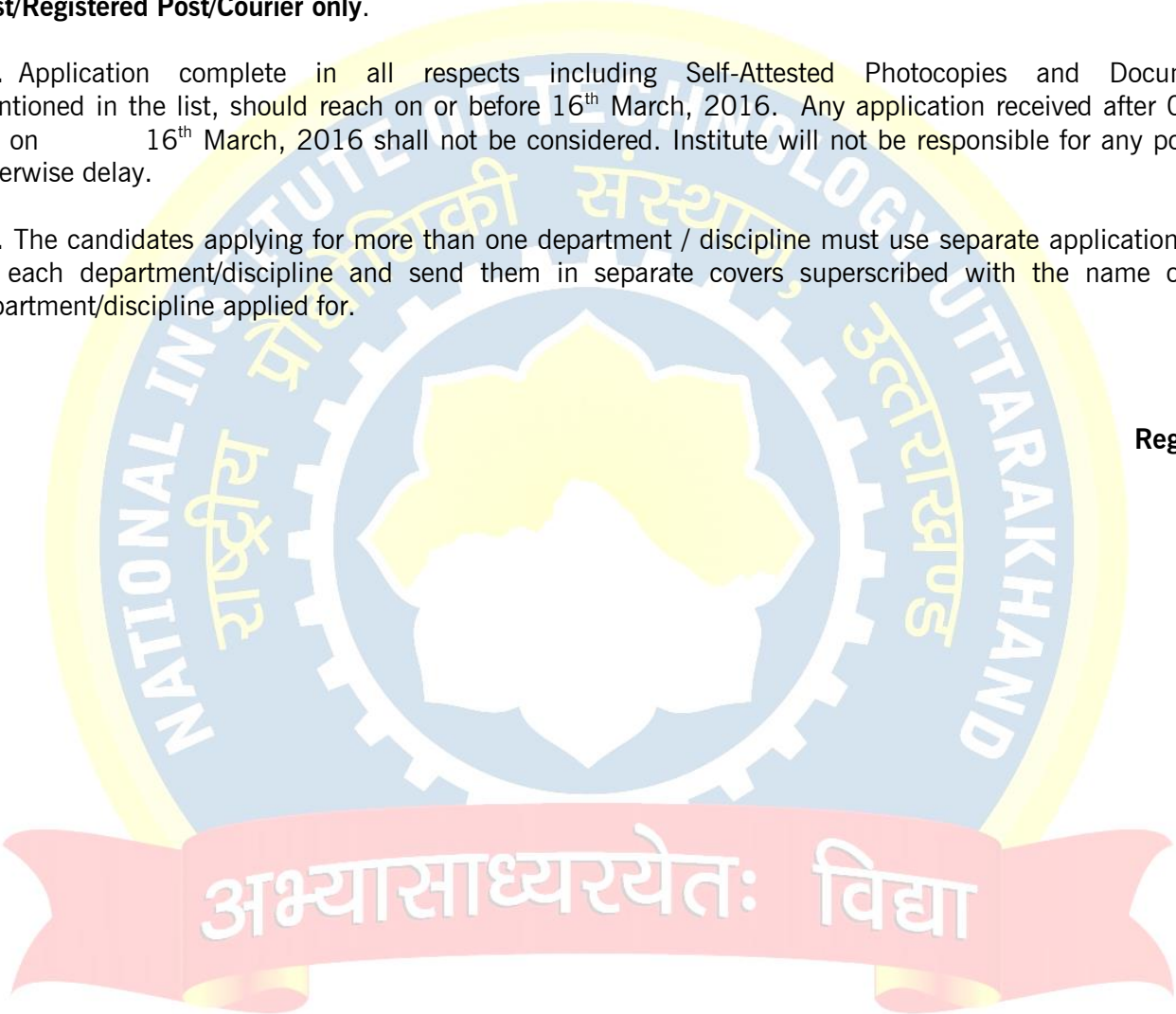
- h. GATE Score Card valid on April-2016. Without valid GATE score, candidate with degree from Institute other than IIT/NIT shall not be considered eligible. If the GATE result is not declared the candidate should produce GATE score at the time of document verification and shall attach related Admit Card alongwith Application Form.
- i. Any other information which the candidate desires to provide (one page only, duly signed).

8. All photocopies and documents including covering letter should be enclosed with application form. Application form must be on front page. All photocopies, documents should be in A4 size. Please do not submit your application in any file, neither use any cover sheet or binding strips etc. Simply tie all the pages by stapler / lace.

9. Application should be sent to the **Registrar, National Institute of Technology, Uttarakhand, Temporary Campus: Govt. ITI, Srinagar (Garhwal), Dist. 10. Application complete in all respects including Self-Attested Photocopies and Documents mentioned in the list, should reach on or before 16th March, 2016. Any application received after 05:30 pm on 16th March, 2016 shall not be considered. Institute will not be responsible for any postal / otherwise delay.

11. The candidates applying for more than one department / discipline must use separate application form for each department/discipline and send them in separate covers superscribed with the name of the department/discipline applied for.

OTHER TERMS AND CONDITIONS

1. Preference will be given to PWD/SC/ST/OBC, if such candidates are available. Candidature of the PWD candidate shall be considered only if the disability of the candidate is permissible for the post to which the candidate is applicant.
2. Category Certificate (for SC/ST/OBC/PWD candidates only) issued by competent authority, if not attached, application will be considered in OPEN category provided candidate fulfills the age and shortlisting criteria for open category. Non-creamy Layer Certificate (for OBC candidates only) is based on parents' income. Candidates are required to submit OBC certificates along with non-creamy layer certificate valid on 16th March, 2016. However, in the absence of necessary certificates proving category, guidelines issued by Government of India will be followed.
3. Persons serving in Govt./Semi-Govt./PSUs should send their applications either through proper channel or furnish a **NO OBJECTION CERTIFICATE** (issued by the competent authority) with application or submit No Objection Certificate (issued by the competent authority) during document verification at the Institute before Skill Test/Written Test/Personal Interview (whichever is earlier). Without the No Objection Certificate (issued by the competent authority), candidature shall be cancelled at the time of document verification. Candidates can send the advance copy of application duly complete in all respects, if applied through proper channel. However, their candidature shall be considered only if copy through proper channel is received by the Institute before document verification.
4. The Institute reserves the right not to fill up the posts, cancel the advertisement in whole or in part, without assigning any reason and its decision in this regard shall be final.
5. Written Test/Personal Interviews shall be conducted at National Institute of Technology, Uttarakhand.
6. Candidates appearing for Written Test/Personal Interview shall be paid To & Fro Bus/Rail fare by sleeper class upto Haridwar from respective Institute/Hometown, subject to submission of tickets.
7. Transport facility from Haridwar and one day shared accommodation at Srinagar (Garhwal) will be provided. Candidates are free to make their own arrangements. Final schedule of transport facilities that will be provided shall be mentioned in the Interview call letter.
8. Incomplete applications or applications without relevant supporting enclosures or applications not in prescribed form will be outrightly rejected. The Institute will not be responsible for any postal delay. Interim correspondence will not be entertained or replied to.

01.	Nature of Programme	To appoint "TRAINEE TEACHERS" (TT) on contractual basis at National Institute of Technologies (NITs) subject to enrollment of the Candidates in Indian Institute of Technologies (IITs) for M.Tech. and Ph.D. programme.
02.	Duration of M.Tech. and Ph.D. programme Mode of Delivery	Maximum 8 years Format: Part-time and Virtual mode with one semester full time in particular IIT.
03.	Teaching Assignments for candidates at parent NIT	12-14 hrs. per week Tutorial, laboratory, project work for initial 1-2 years, subsequently sharing and finally to teaching full course.
04.	Financial support / Salary	Tuition fee as charged by the concerned IIT and monthly consolidated salary paid to TT to be funded by MHRD under this scheme.

In case TT fails to acquire Ph.D. in the stipulated maximum period and also in case s/he discontinues from the service in parent NIT after successfully completion of his Ph.D., the balance amount will be forfeited. If TT fails to acquire Ph.D. in the maximum stipulated time, s/he will be discontinued from this scheme.
09.	Admissions	i. This scheme is open to all graduating candidates who are in top 15% in the Centrally funded Technical Institutes (CFTIs). All other candidates who are in top 15% from other AICTE/UGC approved institutions / universities (non-CFTIs) and having a valid GATE score would also be eligible. ii.
