1. Following documents in original are required for Institute admission:

- a. Document for Proof of date of birth: Class X marksheet/ certificate issued by the school last attended/ Recognized educational board containing the date of birth of the applicant. In case, class X marksheet/certificate does not contain date of birth, the candidate is required to upload class X marksheet/ certificate and any other Government issued document containing date of birth of the applicant, name and Parent's name such as Passport/ Aadhaar Card/ Driving License/ Voter ID Card/ PAN Card/ Birth Certificate issued by Municipal Corporation/authority empowered to register the birth.
- b. Photo ID proof as per Govt. of India norms.
- c. Mark sheet of Class XII/ Equivalence Certificate.
- d. Grade/Mark sheets of qualifying examination for all semesters.
- e. Degree/ Provisional certificate. If the result of qualifying degree is awaited, certificate of course completion from the institute/university last studied or relevant undertaking must be provided in the prescribed format available on the CCMT website.
- f. GATE score card (2022 or 2023 or 2024).
- g. Certificate of category (SC/ST/OBC-NCL/EWS), if applicable, as per Government of India format, available on the CCMT website, issued by the competent authority. **In case of OBC-NCL/EWS category, the certificate must be issued on or after April 01, 2024.**

Please note that

- Caste certificate (SC/ST/OBC-NCL) issued by Maharashtra State must be validated by Social
 Welfare department (in case of SC and OBC-NCL category) and Tribal Welfare department
 (in case of ST category) of Maharashtra Government. The SC/ST/OBC-NCL candidates of
 Maharashtra State have to produce their caste validity certificate in the format available on
 CCMT website.
- ST certificates from Tamil Nadu state must be issued by the concerned Revenue Divisional



Officer.

- h. Declaration by the candidate on OBC-NCL/EWS status in the prescribed format available on CCMT website.
- i. Certificate for Persons with Disabilities (PwD), if applicable, issued by the competent authority. Refer CCMT website for format.

Note: If the original certificates are not in English/Hindi, English/Hindi version/translation of such certificates, duly certified by the Principal/Director or other competent authority, will be required during the document verification.

- 2. Proof of payment of Seat Acceptance Fee (SAF)/PAF/SR Participation Fee/NSR Participation Fee.
- 3. Original Migration certificate of Institute/University last attended
- 4. Original Conduct Certificate from the Institute/University last attended
- 5. Original Transfer certificate from the Institute/University last attended
- 6. Print copy of the Registration form and the locked choices downloaded from the CCMT portal through candidate's login, duly signed by the candidate.
- 7. Provisional Seat Allotment Letter (PSAL) of the finally allotted seat in Round3/Special Round-2/NSR downloaded from the CCMT portal through candidate's login, duly signed by the candidate.
- 8. Online Document Verification Certificate (ODVC) downloaded from the CCMT portal through candidate's login after successful Online Document Verification, duly signed by the candidate.
- 9. One set of self-attested photocopies of all the original documents mentioned in points 1 and 2. The original documents mentioned in point 1 and 2 will be returned to the candidate after verification.
- 10. Three recent passport size color photographs.
- 11. Candidate is required to submit anti-ragging undertakings online through www.antiragging.in.
 - **Step 1:** Log on to www.antiragging.in . Click on the button Fill Undertaking.
 - **Step 2:** Select your university as 'NIT Uttarakhand' and fill all the information by providing college number '9557750897' as required and submit the form.
 - **Step 3:** On successful submission, you will receive an e-mail with your registration number and a web link. You are required to forward the same link to ar.sw@nituk.ac.in / nodoff_antiragging@nituk.ac.in with a copy to academics@nituk.ac.in

12. How to reach NIT Uttarakhand Campus

Temporary Campus of NIT Uttarakhand is located in Govt. Polytechnic College, Srinagar Garhwal (Distt. Pauri Garhwal, Uttarakhand) at Srinagar. Srinagar is about 105 KM from Rishikesh on National Highway No. 58 leading to Badrinath (about 193 KM from Srinagar). Rishikesh is the nearest Railway Station. Haridwar, a major Railway station in Uttarakhand is about 140 km from Srinagar Garhwal. Nearest Airport at Jolly Grant, Dehradun is about 125 km away from Srinagar Garhwal. Taxis are available for Srinagar Garhwal from Airport. Buses and Taxis are available for Srinagar from Dehradun/Rishikesh/Haridwar. It takes around 3 hours to reach Srinagar from Rishikesh. In rainy season, road may be blocked due to land sliding. Candidates are requested to keep a spare day while planning for reporting. Alternate way to reach Srinagar is from Kotdwara (via Pauri), which is about 140 KM and takes around 5 to 6 hours.
