Self-Sponsored (Full time) M.Sc. Admissions for the Academic Year 2026-2027

National Institute of Technology, Uttarakhand invites applications for admission in left over seats of CCMN-2026 (Self-sponsored) after National Spot Round (NSR) of CCMN-2026 for M.Sc. Full Time (Self-Sponsored) Programme in the Department of Physics, Chemistry and Mathematics for the Academic Year 2026-2027. The details are given below.

HOW TO APPLY:

Candidates are required to apply through online portal (link available on the Institute website). The online application form must be submitted along with scan copies of all the documents as mentioned at serial no.4. The candidates are required to apply online and there is no requirement to send the Hard Copy of the application form to the Institute.

1. The details of seats of Self-Sponsored (Full time) M.Sc. Programmes:

Left over seats of CCMN-2026 (Self-sponsored) after National Spot Round (NSR) of CCMN-2026.

3. Important instructions to the candidates:

- The eligibility criteria and qualification will be same as per CCMN 2026. In qualifying degree, the candidates should have passed and secured at least 6.5 CGPA (on a 10- point scale) or 60% for GEN/GEN-EWS/OBC, whereas 6.0 CGPA (on a 10-point scale) or 55% in case of SC/ST/PwD candidates. The above mentioned CGPA/Percentage should be awarded by a recognized University/Institute.

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- b. The seat matrix of left over seats from CCMN-2026 of M.Sc. Programme will be prepared after completion of National Spot Round of CCMN-2026.
- c. The candidates who have valid JAM (2026) and CUET (2026) score card will be eligible for direct admission on left over seats of CCMN -2026. In case of inadequate number of admissions, the Institute will conduct its own entrance examination for admission.
- d. A written test of 50 marks will be conducted based on CUET and JAM syllabus (except CUET/JAM qualified candidates). There will be 50 MCQ type questions for One hour. 30% marks (15 marks) will be the cut-off marks of the candidates.
- e. An application fees of ₹500/- (₹250/- for SC, ST and PwD candidates) is required to be paid online and the same is non-refundable. The Bank details are as under:

- f. In case of final result awaited, an undertaking in the prescribed format has to be uploaded that they shall submit the result up to 31st October, 2026, failing which their admission shall automatically stand cancelled.
- g. Hostel facility will not be provided to the students under this scheme.
- h. No financial assistantship will be provided to the students.
- i. The student will be governed by the rules and regulation of the Institute.
- j. The finally qualified candidates will be informed by a letter via email only.
- k. Valid category certificate (if applicable) must be produced.
- l. OBC-NCL/EWS certificate (if applicable) must be issued on or after 01/04/2026 by the competent authority.
- m. The application without application fee (as applicable) and scan copies of all original documents/certificates/testimonials/undertaking shall be rejected and shall not be considered for shortlisting.
- n. Institute reserves the right to cancel the admission at any stage if found any information is incorrect.
- o. All disputes pertaining to the conduction of Examination and admissions shall fall within the jurisdiction of Uttarakhand only.
- p. The reservation rules as per Government of India norms will be followed at the Institute level on total 20 seats for admission in each department.

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4. The following documents in originals are required for admission:

- 10th standard Certificate and Marksheet as proof of Date of Birth.
- 12th standard Certificate and Marksheet.
- UG Grade Cards/Marksheets of qualifying examination for all semesters.
- Transfer Certificate issued by the Institute last attended.
- Migration Certificate.
- Degree/Provisional Degree certificate. If the result of qualifying degree is awaited, an Undertaking of course completion by the candidate must be provided in the prescribed format available on the website.
- CUET/JAM Score card, if any.
- OBC-NCL/EWS certificate (if applicable) issued on or after 01/04/2026 by the competent authority.
- Certificate of category (SC/ST), if applicable.
- PWD certificate (if applicable).
- Aadhaar Card.

5. Admission Procedure and other Instructions:

- The selected candidates are required to report in Institute for admission during 17th – 18th August, 2026 in the Academic Section, Admin Block of the Institute.**
- Candidates are required to pay Institute fees (₹49,743/-) online as specified at serial no.6.
- Candidate is required to bring all the original documents as mentioned at serial no.4 along with one set of self-attested photocopies of all the documents for admission. All the original documents have to be produced for verification. The admission letter issued by NIT Uttarakhand and fees payment receipt have also to be produced for admission.
- Candidates are advised to visit the Institute website (**www.nituk.ac.in**) frequently to get more updates/any change in schedule of Institute admission/other information.
- Bring 7 recent passport size color photographs.
- Candidate is required to submit anti-ragging undertakings online through www.antiragging.in.

Step-1: Log on to www.antiragging.in or www.AMANMOVEMENT.org. Click on the button called – Register for Undertaking.

Step-2: Select your University as 'NIT Uttarakhand' and fill all the information by providing college number '9557750897' as required and submit the form.

Step-3: On successful submission, you will receive an e-mail with your registration number and a web link. You are required to forward the same link to ad.studentwelfare1@nituk.ac.in with a copy to academics@nituk.ac.in.

- The offline classes will commence from **19th August, 2026** at the Institute.

7. How to reach NIT Uttarakhand, Srinagar Campus:

Campus is located in Srinagar Garhwal, Distt. Pauri Garhwal, Uttarakhand at Srinagar. Srinagar is about 105 KM from Rishikesh on National Highway No.58 leading to Badrinath (about 193 KM from Srinagar). Rishikesh is the nearest Railway Station. Haridwar, a major Railway station in Uttarakhand is about 140 KM from Srinagar Garhwal. Nearest Airport at Jolly Grant, Dehradun is about 125 KM from Srinagar Garhwal. Taxis are available for Srinagar Garhwal from Airport. Buses and Taxis are available for Srinagar from Dehradun/Rishikesh /Haridwar. It takes around 3 hours to reach Srinagar from Rishikesh. In rainy season, road may be blocked due to land sliding. Candidates are requested to keep a spare day while planning for reporting. Alternate way to reach Srinagar is from Kotdwara (via Pauri), which is about 140 KM and takes around 5 hours.
